Following the sell-out success of *A Gamble With Death*, creators Richard Alexander and Alex Farthing are back with a brand new live-action interactive adventure for families, colleagues and friends this Autumn. Using their smartphones, players must **race around the streets of Reading** to find hidden evidence, crack cryptic clues and converse with suspicious characters to catch the culprit – before the time runs out.

A Melody For Murder is 3-hour live-action treasure hunt with a difference. Imagine the crystal maze, some escape room puzzles, a scavenger hunt, a team of live actors, your smartphone and a murder mystery all got together - with a timer. Even more local businesses and iconic Reading locations are in on the action this time round, with clues hidden all around the Town Centre.

This new concept sees players working as solo sleuths or as teams of intrepid detectives searching the streets of Reading against the clock, and uniquely allows them to discover hidden gems around the town, **explore Reading's history and crack the case in an intriguing new way**.

The game centres around the murder of multi-millionaire singer and long-time diva, Stella Chord, who was rehearsing *The Bel Canto Melody* for her 100th concert at *The Hexagon* in Reading. But a lighting rig came crashing down - and she never reached the final bars. Police suspect the dramatic finish to the piece wasn't quite what she had in mind.
